MAKE YOUR OWN CELEBRATION BUNTING

VE day was a celebration of 'Victory in Europe'. It happened towards the end of the Second World War in May 1945. At last people in Britain were allowed to go out without restriction and they planned big street parties outside their homes to celebrate. They brought decorations, food and music along...anything they had to share.

You can make your own bunting using some recycled materials like old cereal packets, bits of old wrapping paper and fabric from old clothes or bed linen. Anything you can find around the house.

What you need:

Card for the triangle template Old fabric or coloured paper String Glue or sticky tape Pencil Scissors



How to:

- 1. Make a card triangle using the templates below (there are large and small).
- 2. Use the card template to draw round the old fabric or coloured paper and cut out your triangles.
- 3. Fold over about 1cm at the top of each triangle (shortest side).
- 4. Tuck a piece of string underneath the folds so the triangles link together.
- 5. Stick down the folds.
- 6. Wait for the glue to dry and there you have your own unique bunting.
