Bullers of Buchan is a collapsed 245 foot sea cave, and can be found five miles north of Cruden Bay. There is a spectacular three mile walk along the cliffs which brings you to the ruins of Slains Castle.

Whinnyfold is a tiny village, 1-storey and attic fishermen's cottages, sitting at the top of cliffs south of Cruden Bay
